The **Wolverine Clean Energy Venture** is Wolverine Power Cooperative's development of new electric generation projects near Rogers City, Michigan. The Wolverine Clean Energy Venture has two components:

- A solid fuel power plant that will operate as a base load plant. Base load power plants operate continuously and with great efficiency.
- A wind farm that will capture a renewable natural resource and convert it to electricity.

Wolverine Power Cooperative is developing the **Wolverine Clean Energy Venture** to meet our members' long-term power needs with cleanly produced, cost-effective electricity.
