

Economic Impact



The **Wolverine Clean Energy Venture** will have significant financial impact on the Rogers City area and our state.

The power plant represents a capital investment of more than \$1 billion and will double the state equalized value (SEV) of Presque Isle County where the plant will be built.

Construction of the power plant will create 1,000 temporary jobs, and 100 permanent positions will be filled to operate the plant. Jobs in engineering, plant operations and plant maintenance will be created at salaries ranging from \$40,000 to \$100,000 per year plus benefits.

We are presently working with Alpena Community College on the development of apprenticeship programs to train operators needed for the plant.

The economic benefits and employment opportunities the power plant brings to the Rogers City area are real and welcomed by many who live and work in Presque Isle County. If a wind farm proves viable, additional capital investment and employment opportunities will result.
